

Preparing Your Home for Photography

Each of our photographers shoot 5-6 homes per day. In most cases we plan for approximately 20-30 minutes at your home to do the photography (for an average size property).

Our photographers take pride in arriving on time, so having your home prepared and ready to go at your scheduled appointment time means we can spend more time planning how to best showcase your homes' features.

Also, please note that our photographers are not allowed to touch or move any of your furniture or belongings and they are not able to make home staging recommendations.

		ALL LIGHTS ON! (*REPLACE BURNED OUT BULBS) DRAPERIES, BLINDS AND SHUTTERS OPEN REARRANGE FURNITURE AS DESIRED. DISHES DONE AND REMOVED FROM SINK. REMOVE ALL MAGNETS, NOTES ETC. FROM REFRIGERATOR. CLEAR KITCHEN COUNTERTOPS AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE. MAKE ALL BEDS CLEAN ALL BATHROOMS AND REMOVE PERSONAL ITEMS REMOVE TOWELS ETC. HANGING BEHIND BATHROOM DOORS
